

WAHMingIt.com Washcloth



This pattern must be knit on either long double point needles or a circular needle.

Measurements:

Small Cloth: 9" x 6.5"

Large Cloth: 10" x 7"

Materials:

100% cotton worsted weight yarn in 2 colors (1 ball in each color would easily make 2 cloths)

Size 7 circular or long double point needles (2) or needles to obtain gauge
For Optional Edging: Crochet Hook equivalent to needles used for cloth (I used a size G)

Gauge: 5 stitches = 1"

Abbreviations:

Wyib: with yarn in back

Wyif: with yarn in front

Sl: slip

Sc: single crochet (optional edging)

Dc: double crochet (optional edging)

Directions are written for smaller cloth with larger size in ()

Using long tail method, cast on 35 (45) stitches.

Row 1: With A, purl.
Row 2: With B, knit. Slide stitches to other end of needle.
Row 3: With A, knit.
Row 4: With B, p1, *sl 3 wyif, p7; repeat from *, ending with sl 3, p1. Slide stitches to other end of needle.
Row 5: With A, purl.
Row 6: With B, k1, *sl 3 wyib, k7; rep from *, ending with sl 3, k1. Slide stitches to other end of needle.
Row 7: With A, knit.
Row 8: With B, p1, *sl 3 wyif, p7; repeat from *, ending with sl 3, p1. Slide stitches to other end of needle.
Row 9: With A, purl.
Row 10: With B, knit. Slide stitches to other end of needle.
Row 11: With A, knit.
Row 12: With B p6, *sl 3 wyif, p7; repeat from *, ending with sl3, p6. Slide stitches to the other end of needle.
Row 13: With A, purl.
Row 14: With B, k6, *sl3 wyib, k7; repeat from *, ending with sl 3, k6. Slide stitches to other end of needle.
Row 15: With A, knit.
Row 16: With B, p6, *sl 3 wyif, p7; repeat from *, ending with sl3, p6. Slide stitches to the other end of needle.
Repeat Rows 1 – 16 1 (2) more times.
Knit 1 row in A. Bind off. Weave in ends.

Optional Crochet Edging:

Round 1: Single crochet around the cloth (1 sc in each knit stitch/row).

Round 2: 1 sc, *skip 1 sc, 5 dc into next sc, skip 1 sc, 1sc into next sc, repeat from * .
